

Language: Hebrew

From Scratch to the Bible. The course is a 10 ECTS crash course in Biblical Hebrew. You will be trained in basic Hebrew grammar, enough to make you able to read biblical texts such as Genesis and the Book of Psalms.

The course is taught as e-learning, including a two-hour weekly video conference call via Zoom. It will be taught in the 'flipped classroom' style, meaning that you will watch online video lectures as part of your preparation for class. This means that we will not have to use time on lectures in class, giving students more time to having their queries cleared up. The lectures and textbook are found here:

Weekly conference call

Students present in Copenhagen are welcome to come to my office for the classes. I will audio record the classes and share them with you in Canvas. We will use Copenhagen's Canvas, called Absalon.

Reading for the first class

For the first class, please read the Wikipedia entry on biblical Hebrew: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Biblical_Hebrew. Then watch the first three videos and complete exercise 1. Please also read exercise 1 aloud to yourself or your study partners three times, so as to practice reading Hebrew.

Time period

Teaching: Week 6-18, thus the first class will be on 5. February and the last class will be on 30. April. I will be lecturing in Abu Dhabi in the week of 9. April, so there will be no class that week. There will be a break for Easter, so there will be no classes on 16. April. Please note further that I will be on holiday in the week of 23. April. Reading week by week

12. February. For this class, please watch lessons 4-5 and complete exercises 2-3.
19. February. Watch lessons 6-7 and complete exercises 4-5.
26. February. Watch lessons 8-9 and complete exercises 6-7.
5. March. Watch lessons 10-11 and complete exercises 8-9.
10. March. Compact seminar; face-to-face Hebrew class in Copenhagen (timing 10:30-12:00) in room 8B-0-54. Repetition of grammar, please look over the exercises we have completed so far. The usual Zoom room will be open for students not attending the compact seminar or not present in Copenhagen.
19. March. Watch lessons 12-13 and complete exercise 10-11.
26. March. Watch lesson 14-15 and complete exercise 12-13.
2. April. Watch lesson 16 and read, translate, and analyze Genesis 1, verse 1-5.
23. April. Watch lesson 16 again and read, translate and analyze Genesis 1, verse 6-12. Please note, I'm on holiday this week. I will teach via Zoom at our regular Wednesday time but will not be present in my office in Copenhagen.
30. April. Watch lesson 16 one more time and read, translate and analyze Genesis 1, verse 13-21.

Syllabus

Genesis 1-4; Psalm 24.

Exam

For the exam you will be asked to translate and linguistically comment upon a text from the syllabus. The text will be a few verses long. You will receive the text on 5. May at noon and should hand in your paper in our digital exam system before 6. May at noon.

NB: Note that you must receive and hand in the exam question in the digital system. Make sure that you have access and that you check our UCPH email daily.
